

# Deadlines for Provisional Licenses



### **Cultivation Size Limits Begin**

**JANUARY 1, 2022** 

DCC will no longer <u>ISSUE</u> provisional cultivation licenses for applications submitted after this date \*\*if the new license would cause a licensee to hold multiple licenses on contiguous premises exceeding one acre of outdoor or 22k sq ft of mixed-light or indoor\*\*.

### **General Deadline to Submit**

**MARCH 31, 2022** 

Subject to restriction in **RED**, any applicant must file new applications for a provisional license of any type on or before this date UNLESS applicant meets an exception below.

DCC Deadline to ISSUE Provisional June 30, 2022

## **Exception 1 Small Farmer**

**JUNE 30, 2022** 

Subject to the restriction in **RED**, an applicant applying for a premises less than 20k sq ft of outdoor canopy can apply for a new provisional license.

DCC Deadline to ISSUE Provisional September 30, 2022

## Exception 2 Social Equity Applicant

**MARCH 31, 2023** 

Subject to the restriction in **RED**, a social equity applicant can apply for a new provisional license, including cultivation, if for less than an acre of outdoor or 22k sq ft of indoor or mixed-light.

DCC Deadline to ISSUE Provisional June 30, 2023

## **Issuance and Renewal** Requirements

**JULY 1, 2021 - JUNE 30, 2022** 

To receive and renew a provisional, an applicant needs to submit:

- (1) local authorization that compliance is underway
- (2) evidence CEQA compliance is underway; and
- (3) notification that LSAA submitted, paid, and in good standing.

#### **JULY 1, 2022 - JUNE 30, 2023**

**LSAA** – Submit final, draft, or notification that application is complete, or notification not needed.

**CEQA** – Written communication evidencing in process of a site-specific initial study, addendum, or checklist to identify environmental impacts that lead agency substantial progress during previous 12-months.

JULY 1, 2023 + FORWARD LSAA – Submit final or draft agreement, or notification not needed.

**CEQA** – Written verification that local jurisdiction has: (i) prepared and circulated a mitigated or negative declaration; (ii) determined environmental impact report is required and substantial progress made; (iii) prepared and completed site specific review and prepared initial study, addendum or checklist; or (iv) prepared and completed a notice of exemption.

## Provisional License Renewal **Deadline - Large Cultivation**

#### **JANUARY 1, 2023**

DCC will no longer **RENEW** provisional cultivation licenses after this date \*\*if the new license would cause a licensee to hold multiple licenses on contiguous premises exceeds one acre of outdoor or 22k sq ft of mixed-light or indoor\*\*. No provisional that causes a licensee to exceed one acre of outdoor or 22k sq ft of mixed light shall be in effect as of January 1, 2024.

## Provisional License Renewal Deadline - All License Types

**JANUARY 1, 2025** 

DCC will no longer **RENEW** any provisional license. No further exemptions from annual licenses will be adopted.

## **Sunset of** Provisional License Program

**JANUARY 1, 2026**
